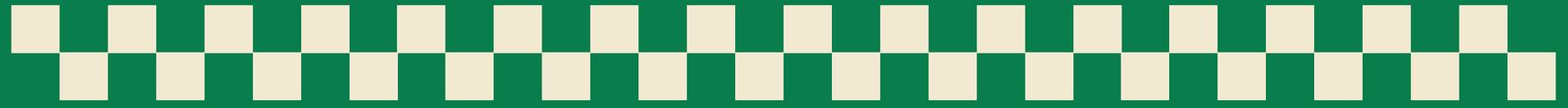


Are you someone living with an eating disorder or have lived experience of food/eating-related distress?
